

a comprehensive virtual library on the world-wide web with 40,000 items (number of discrete pages) indexed with a total number of more than 1,576,000 keywords. To compliment our website, we had 18 free lectures/events for the public to enjoy.

Our affiliate, *The Lower Merion Society for the Detection and Prosecution of Horse Thieves and the Recovery of Stolen Horses* (Established in 1818) had its 199th Annual History Banquet of the Olde Society. Plans are in progress to celebrate their upcoming 200th anniversary.
